# ADVISORY CIRCULAR

SUBJECT: OBSTRUCTION MARKING AND LIGHTING

---

1. PURPOSE. This advisory circular describes the FAA standards on obstruction marking and lighting and establishes the methods, procedures and equipment types for both aviation red and high intensity white obstruction lights.
2. CANCELLATION. This circular cancels and supersedes Advisory Circular No. 70/7460-1 dated February 1968.
3. EXPLANATION OF REVISIONS. The standards have been amended to include lighting with high intensity white lights for daytime marking in lieu of painting on smokestacks and similar structures; however, this is not applicable to skeletal type structures.
