Describe consumer outreach efforts in the past 12 months: For the months that ACT was a provider of CMRS services during 2013, the Company had instructed its sales staff about the availability of hearing-aid compatible phone models and it had signs in each store advertising the availability of HAC devices. The Company's sales staff was aware of the HAC-compliant issue and has been trained to respond to customer inquiries regarding HAC phones. The Company also had wireless industry pamphlets available that customers could take home with information about the FCC's HAC requirements and the HAC rating system. In addition, both hearing impaired and non-hearing impaired customers were permitted to test phones in retail stores.
