Dear Mr. Schlichting:

Pursuant to Section 27.607 of the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC") rules¹ Access 700, LLC ("Access 700"), a subsidiary of Access Spectrum, LLC, is pleased to provide this Annual Report on its provision of band management services in the 700 MHz band.

As of March 1, 2009, Access 700 has entered into seven Spectrum Use Agreements ("SUAs") with three spectrum lessees. Two of the lessees are actually sublessees on a *de facto* transfer lease in which Access 700 is the lessee. Five of the lease agreements are for the full 2 MHz of spectrum associated with each license, and of the two subleases, one is for 262.5 kHz and the other is for 225 kHz of spectrum. The spectrum is used by Access 700's customers for mobile data and two-way voice operations. All of the SUAs are spectrum manager lease agreements. Three of the leases are for a 6-1/2 year term; two of the leases are for less than one year; and the two subleases are for less than one year.
