Dear Ms. Milkman:

Pursuant to Section 27.607 of the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC") rules¹ and the *Memorandum Opinion and Order* granting its request for waiver to provide band management services in the 220-222 MHz band,² Access 220, LLC ("Access 220"), a subsidiary of Access Spectrum, LLC, is pleased to provide this Annual Report on its progress in providing band management services utilizing its 220-222 MHz licenses.

As of March 1, 2011, Access 220 has five Spectrum Use Agreements ("SUAs"), all of which are spectrum manager lease agreements. Their terms, type of system and amount of spectrum leased are set forth below.

SUA 1:	5-year term; fixed data services, 5 kHz
SUA 2:	10-year term; fixed data services, 5 kHz
SUA 3:	10-year term; fixed data services, 5 kHz
SUA 4:	10-year term; two-way radio system, 4 5-kHz channels
SUA 5:	10-year term; fixed data services, 2 5-kHz pairs
