

Instructions for Table E: ITFS Pending Applications

These instructions are for reviewing *Table E: Instructional Television Fixed Service (ITFS) Pending Applications* and submitting corrections to the data for on this table. This table of licensing information is provided in accordance with Public Notice DA 02-2751, released October 18, 2002.

The table includes all pending application that have been filed electronically as of October 16, 2002, and all that have been filed manually prior to August 1, 2002.

Table Organization

Table E: ITFS Pending Applications is sorted by applicant/licensee name and contains the following information:

- Applicant/Licensee Name
- File Number
- Purpose of Application filing – includes one of the Application Purpose codes listed below
 - AL: Assignment of License
 - AP: Assignment of Permit
 - C: Initial Certification of Completion of Construction
 - E: Extension of Time to Construct
 - LMP: Major Modification to a Licensed Facility
 - LNA: Minor Amendment an Application for a Licensed Facility
 - LNP: Minor Modification to a Licensed Facility
 - MA: Major Amendment to a Pending Application
 - MC: Certification of Completion of Construction (for a licensed station)
 - MP: Major Modification
 - NA: Minor Amendment to a Pending Application
 - NP: Minor Modification
 - P: New Permit
 - R: Renewal
 - STA: Special Temporary Authority
- Call Sign
- Facility ID
- Transmitter City/State
- Basic Trading Area
- Channel List

Section 1: Reviewing the Data in Table E

Review the data for your ITFS pending applications in Table E.

Note that applications for an Assignment or Transfer of Control will be listed with only one call sign on Table E. Additional call signs may be included in the Assignment or Transfer, but those additional call signs will not be included in Table E. (For a full list of those call signs, you may query the BLS database at <http://wireless.fcc.gov/services/itfs&mds/licensing/> and click on the link to search for Applications and search by Application File Number.)

A. Incorrect Statuses

ITFS applicants should verify that their pending ITFS application is accurately included in Table E and that any application that has been Granted, Dismissed, Denied, Canceled or Withdrawn does not appear on this list as Pending.

- If an application is listed as Pending, but has been Granted, the licensee must submit
- A copy of the associated license or other authorization or documentation that demonstrates that the application has been Granted
- A cover letter that includes the following information:
 - The Table to be corrected (Table E)
 - The Call Sign and File Number
 - The Facility ID, if known
 - The Licensee's FCC Registration Number
 - The current Name, Address and Phone number of the Licensee's Contact Representative

If an application is listed as Pending, but has been Canceled, Withdrawn, Denied or Dismissed, the applicant must submit

- Updated information concerning the status of the application
- A cover letter that includes the following information:
 - The Table to be corrected (Table E)
 - The Call Sign and File Number
 - The Facility ID, if known
 - The Licensee's FCC Registration Number
 - The current Name, Address and Phone number of the Licensee's Contact Representative

B. Omitted Pending Applications

If an application is believed to be Pending and is not included on Table E, the applicant must submit

- Two FCC date-stamped copies of that filing
- A cover letter that includes the following information:
 - The Table to be corrected (Table E)
 - The Call Sign and File Number
 - The Facility ID, if known
 - The Licensee's FCC Registration Number
 - The current Name, Address and Phone number of the Licensee's Contact Representative

C. Applications filed prior to March 25, 2002

For all pending applications filed prior to March 25, 2002, the applicant must submit

- A written affirmation that continued processing of the application is requested
- A copy of the application
- A cover letter that includes the following information:
 - The Table to be corrected (Table E)
 - The Call Sign and File Number
 - The Facility ID, if known
 - The Licensee's FCC Registration Number
 - The current Name, Address and Phone number of the Licensee's Contact Representative

D. Reviewing Technical Parameters of Applications Listed on Table E

After you have reviewed the status of the application, and determined that the application remains pending before the Commission, you should review any technical data that was included on that filing by using the BLS Inventory Search.

(<http://svartifoss2.fcc.gov/BlsQuery/inventory/LicenseSearch.html>).

Follow the instructions posted at that site for searching the database and submitting corrections to the technical parameters of the Pending application. If you have found that both the status and the technical parameters are in error, submit all corrections together in a single data correction filing.

Note: Technical data does not apply to applications to Assign, Transfer, Certify or Extend Construction, or Renewals. Technical data is available in the BLS Inventory only for New Permits, Modifications and Amendments.

If the status of the authorization is correct in Table E, and if the technical data provided at the BLS Inventory web site is correct, no further action is required if the application was filed after March 25, 2002.

Section 2: Submission of Data Corrections

Corrections to the status of a license and/or to the technical parameters must be submitted to the address listed below, and must be filed within the timeframe announced by Public Notice DA 02-2751, released October 18, 2002. All technical data corrections must comply with the instructions as noted at the BLS Inventory web site at (<http://svartifoss2.fcc.gov/BlsQuery/inventory/LicenseSearch.html>).
